**MARINE ENGINEER OFFICERS LICENSURE EXAMINATION
RESULTS RELEASED IN FOUR (4) DAYS**

The **Professional Regulation Commission (PRC)** announces that **658** out of **1,189** passed the various grades of the written phase of the **MARINE ENGINEER OFFICERS LICENSURE EXAMINATIONS** given by the Board for Marine Engineer Officers in Manila this **September 2011**.

The members of the Board for Marine Engineer Officers are **Engr. Miguel O. Marasigan**, Officer-in-Charge; **Engr. Victoriano A. Alojado**, **Engr. Ferdinand R. Pascua** and **Engr. Eldefonso G. Uba**, Members.

The results were released after four (4) days from the last day of examinations.

Registration for the issuance of Certificate of Registration and Professional Identification Cards for those who are exempted in the practical assessment will start on September 28, 2011 but not later than October 21, 2011.

In addition, **428** applicants were approved for upgrading as **Chief Marine Engineer Officers** as per **Board Res. No. 87** dated June 1, 2011, **Board Res.
