**MINING ENGINEER LICENSURE EXAMINATION  
 RESULTS RELEASED IN TWO (2) WORKING DAYS**

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **7** out of **9** passed the Mining Engineer Licensure Examination given by the **Board of Mining Engineering in Manila** this **December 2010**.

The members of the Board of Mining Engineering are **Cornelio Q. Casido**, Chairman; **Rufino B. Bomasang** and **Augusto C. Villaluna**, Members.

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will start on Monday, December 20, 2010. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, current Community Tax Certificate (cedula), 2 pieces passport size picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 1 piece 1" x 1" picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 2 sets of metered documentary stamps, and 1 short brown envelope with name and profession; and to pay the Initial Registration Fee of ₱600 and Annual Registration Fee of ₱450 for 2010-2013. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The date and venue for the oathtaking ceremony of the successful examinees in the said examination as well as the previous ones who have not taken their Oath of Professional **WILL BE ANNOUNCED LATER.**

Registration for membership with the **Philippine Society of Mining Engineers, Inc. (PSEM)** will take place after registration as a professional with the Board and the Commission.
