SANITARY ENGINEER LICENSURE EXAMINATION RESULTS RELEASED IN TWO (2) WORKING DAYS

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **50** out of **96** passed the **Sanitary Engineer Licensure Examination** given by the **Board of Sanitary Engineering** in **Manila** this **January 2018**.

The members of the Board of Sanitary Engineering who gave the licensure examination are **Engr. Corazon De los Reyes-Romero**, Chairman; **Engr. Alfredo B. Espino** and **Engr. Florimond M. Lara**, Members.

The results were released in two (2) working days from the last day of examination.

From January 25 to January 26, 2018, registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will be done on-line. Please go to www.prc.gov.ph and follow instructions for initial registration. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, notice of admission (for identification only), 2 pieces passport sized pictures (colored with white background and complete name tag), 2 sets of documentary stamps and 1 piece short brown envelope. Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.

The date and venue for the oathtaking ceremony of the successful examinees in the said examination **WILL BE ANNOUNCED LATER**.
